Eligibility Hours Requirement Increasing June 1



Active Eligibility



Hours to maintain eligibility will be 300 per quarter or 1200 for the four quarter lookback.

Apprentice Eligibility



Hours to maintain eligibility will be 200 per quarter or 960 for the four quarter lookback.

When is this effective?

This change will be effective for the June 1st Coverage Quarter. This includes the hours worked from January 1 - March 31, 2025 or the hours worked from the four quarter lookback from April 1, 2024 - March 31, 2025.

Why is this changing?

Healthcare costs are continually increasing. The true cost of coverage is over \$1800 a month, or 420+ hours a quarter. Increasing the eligibility requirements allows the plan to remain sustainable for years to come.

What if I don't work enough hours?

Members in good standing (current on Dues) can continue eligibility through the Self-Pay Option. Additional options include COBRA and Low Cost Plan of Benefits.
